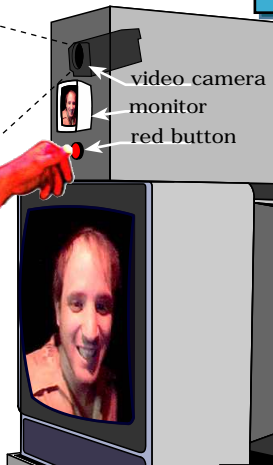


How prontophot works:

black backdrop behind the visitor

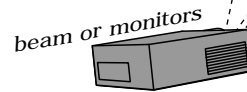


1. Start:
You see yourself in the preview-monitor with instructions to press the red button.

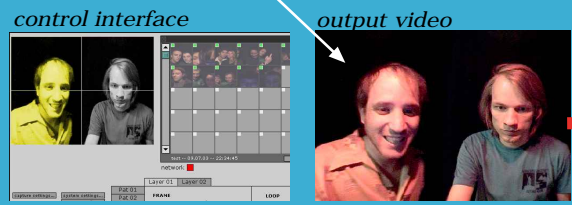
2. Capture:
Once the button is pressed, the video-camera captures a sequence of about 15 images within two seconds.



5. Projection:
Immediately after capturing prontophot puts you on display.

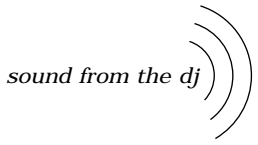
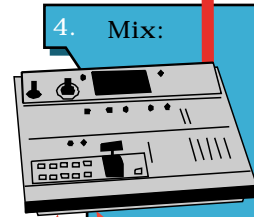


3. Process:
All image-sequences are stored in a database on the computer. The output-video is composed out of several images from the database, using the sound to trigger the animation. The control interface is used by us to arrange this composition.



4. Mix:
background-video from DVD-player or powerbook

During a VJ-performance we mix the video from prontophot with a background using the lumakey of the videomixer.
